Form of participation: In-person or online. Conference languages: Ukrainian, English.

Sectional sessions will take place on **September 3, 2025**, in the **Red Hall** of Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University. It is a magnificent historical building, the former Residence of the Metropolitans of Bukovyna and Dalmatia.

On **September 4, 2025**, participants are invited to take part in an **excursion to Vyzhnytsia**, located at the foothills of the Carpathians, 70 km from Chernivtsi. During the excursion, participants will visit the Nazariy Yaremchuk Museum, enjoy picturesque landscapes at the Nimchych Pass, visit a local Carpathian apiary, and taste a delicious homemade lunch hosted by Father Vasyl. The cost of the excursion is 50 euros per person.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The abstracts must be submitted in *.docx or *.doc format using Microsoft Word text editor. The abstract length should be 2 to 5 pages, A5 size. Page margins — 15 mm on all sides. Font — Arial, size 11 pt, paragraph indent — 7.5 mm, line spacing — 1.0, no spacing before or after paragraphs. Text must be justified. Hyphenation is not allowed. Tables and figures may be included. Font size for tables — 9 pt.

In-text references should be in round brackets with the author's last name and year (Author, 2024). Footnotes or endnotes are not allowed. The list of references should be arranged in alphabetical order according to the APA Style.

The submitted manuscript must be original and **will not be edited**. Authors are responsible for the content of their materials. Materials that do not meet the formatting requirements may be rejected without a refund of the registration fee.

References (10 pt, not bold, centered) (Formatted according to APA Style)
